

COURSE OVERSEEDING

The golf course and practice facility will be CLOSED for Overseeding from October 30th – November 18th. The course will reopen following Overseeding on Sunday, November 19th. When the club reopens the course will be CART PATH ONLY for about two weeks. Call the golf shop at 520-838-6645 to check on any restrictions. Enjoy your time away from the club!

CART DRIVING RULES

Golf carts provide golfers a way to enjoy the game without the added stress of a several mile walk. Our course has traffic control measures such as cart directional signs, stakes, and ropes. These measures reduce the amount of turf damage that comes with cart traffic. Where you should be

driving your cart depends on course conditions, weather, irrigation, soil, drainage, and cart traffic levels. Thank you for remaining on the path during the entire round following overseeding. The newly overseeded fairways are still growing in, and the turf is too fragile to handle carts driving across. Throughout most of the year we use the 90 degree rule. Carts are to be parked well away from putting greens, tees, and their surrounding areas. Keep all four tires on the cart path when parking to prevent any worn areas with common parking locations.

ASHER TOUR TOURNAMENT RECAP

The Asher Tour Sewailo Championship was held on October 3rd – 5th. The Asher Tour is the longest running professional mini-tour in the country. Matthew Cole is the Sewailo Championship winner

with a 3 day total of 15-under par 198. Cole fired rounds of 66, 70, and 62 to win by one shot. His final round 62 was bogey free and included 6 birdies in a row. Matthew Cole holed some clutch putts coming down the closing stretch. Cole earned \$12,500 for the victory.

GOLF TIP: SPOT PUTTING

Spot putting is when you pick a spot near the hole and attempt to roll the ball over that spot. Pick a spot on the green other than the cup (piece of grass, ball or spike mark) and line up to it. This

spot can be an inch to six inches out in front of the ball. It is easier to align yourself to a spot close to you than way out in the distance. Use the alignment aid on your putter to line up square to the spot you are choosing and then stroke the ball towards it.

When you are rolling a longer putt, pick a spot on the green where the ball starts to break toward the hole. You will be reading the green to find the "apex", which is the furthest point outside the hole where the ball starts to turn in the other direction.
