REPAIRING BALL MARKS

If golfers fail to repair a ball mark, there can be long lasting damage. Unrepaired ball marks can take weeks to heal. These ball marks can cause balls to bounce off line. It is important to be mindful of repairing your ball mark, and any unrepaired marks nearby. Any single-pronged and fork-tools can be used to effectively repair the mark, including a tee. Using proper technique will help the mark heal. Insert the tool behind the ball mark and gently push the top of the tool toward the center of the indentation. Tap down the mark with your putter to smooth the surface. After hitting a great shot into a green, fix your ball mark and help our superintendent

maintain high quality playing conditions.

fit for a new Odyssey Ai One putter. Contact the golf shop at 520-838-6645 to reserve your putter fitting. The Odyssey Ai-ONE putters contain a urethane insert for more consistent ball speed, even on off center hits. The result is your putts will finish up 21% closer to the hole. The Ai-One insert designed using artificial intelligence. There are contours on the aluminum back of the insert, and the insert is molded into a white hot urethane striking surface for consistent ball speeds across the face. The white hot insert offers soft

feel and sound. There is also a milled line with a champagne colored milled titanium insert in a milled stainless steel head. The titanium insert has a large sweet spot and forgiveness, minimizing speed loss on putts struck away from the face. The Stroke Lab steel SL 90 shaft has 30 grams of weight in the butt end for counterbalancing.

PRE-SHOT ROUTINE

A good pre – shot routine helps you focus on positive thoughts during the time you are preparing for a shot. The routine helps a player get comfortable and set up with accurate alignment. Develop your own pre-shot routine that is natural to you, then prepare to hit your shot the same way each time. A good routine starts from behind the ball. This is where you look down your line of play and visualize the shot. Take a deep breath to allow the body to relax and prepare to execute. Check the lie which may be uphill,

downhill, or sidehill. Adjust your ball position and grip if needed. Figure the wind direction and get the yardage. Visualize the ball flying with a specific flight. Pick out an intermediate target in front of the ball to help you align the clubface. Make your best swing and then evaluate your shot.
